Each member is paid per call as well as for each training meeting. Taylor County also participates in the Fire Fighters Retirement Pension Fund for firefighters and provides Cancer Policy insurance for all firefighters.

Remember, to be a Firefighter with Taylor County you do NOT have to run into burning buildings as there are MANY positions needed outside of the hot zone.

Hours of duty are when YOU are available.

There are no set required hours times or days of service when you must be on duty.
